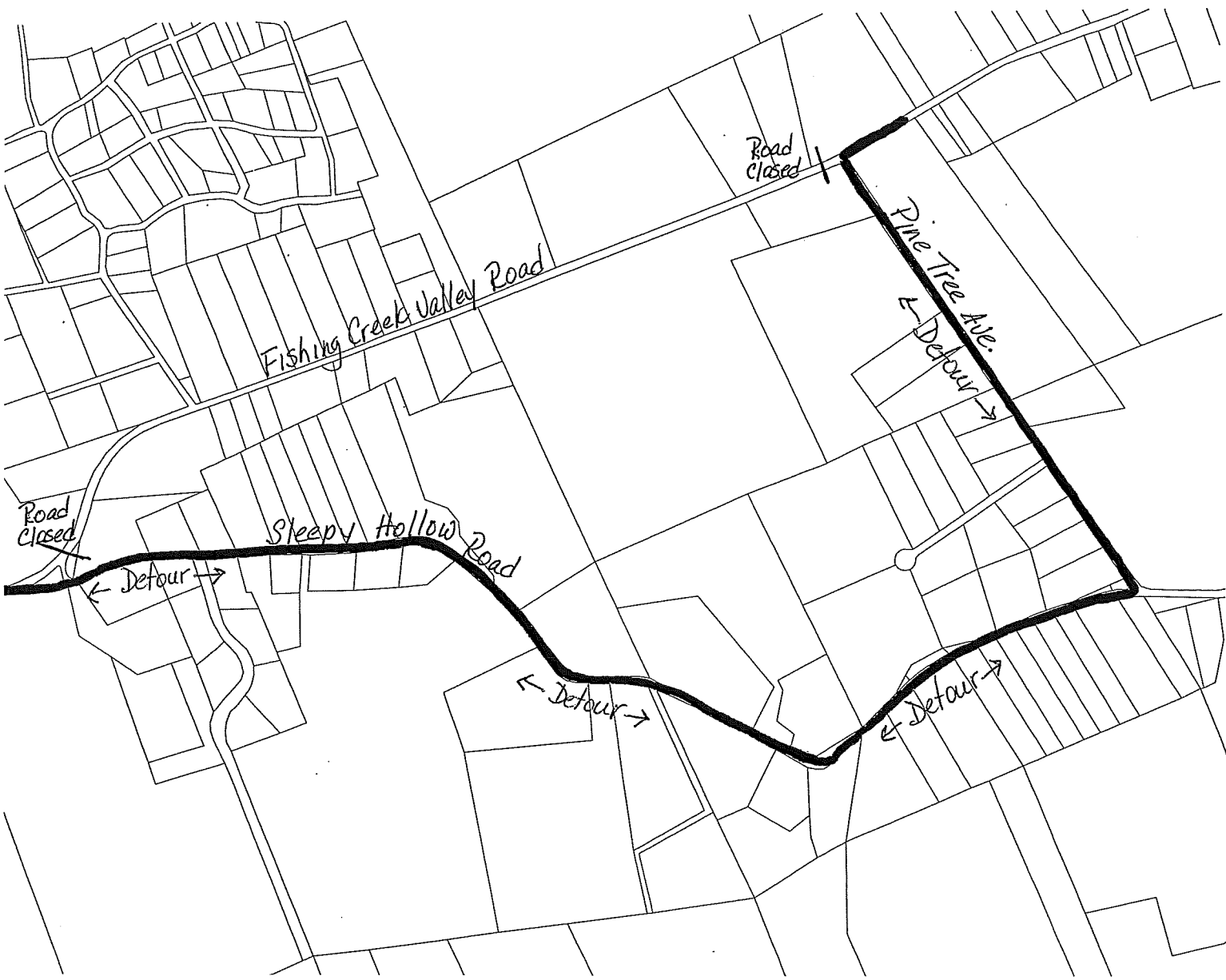


Fishing Creek Valley Road Culvert Replacement

West Hanover Township has just been notified by PennDOT of a major construction project on Fishing Creek Valley Road, Route 443. The project consists of removing an old culvert and replacing it with a larger box culvert on the stream running under Fishing Creek Valley Road just west of Pine Tree Ave. The project is scheduled to last approximately three (3) weeks and will necessitate closing Fishing Creek Valley Road from Sleepy Hollow Road to Pine Tree Ave. Local traffic will be permitted on Fishing Creek Valley Road but there will be no through traffic permitted as the entire width of the road will be excavated for the culvert replacement.

PennDOT has already erected some warning signs and more warning devices will be placed in service. The detour around the area will be utilizing Sleepy Hollow Road and Pine Tree Ave. and will be appropriately marked. Construction is scheduled to take place from Monday, June 15, 2009, to approximately Friday, July 3, 2009, weather permitting.

Fishing Creek Valley Road is a state road, not a Township road. Therefore, all aspects of the construction, road closing, and detour arrangements have been made by PennDOT. If you have any questions please feel free to call PennDOT at 787-5391
