Our trip fees do not include gratuity for the bus driver. **A \$2.00 gratuity per person is suggested and collected on each trip.** Seating is first-come, first-served basis, and seats retained throughout the trip. ## **REFUND POLICY**

- If trip is cancelled due to insufficient registration you will receive a full refund.
- Regular trip you must cancel out within 30 days.
- If the participant cancels 30 days prior to trip, you will receive a full Refund, minus a \$15pp. administration fee.
- If participant cancels after the 30days you forfeit all rights to the seats, tickets & fee. The seat, ticket & fee then become the property of West Hanover Township.

**Nemours & Mt. Cuba (Sat. May 1)**

Originally constructed in 1910, **Nemours Mansion** is one of the grandest buildings ever constructed in Delaware and includes the largest formal French garden in North America.

The mansion contains more than seventy rooms spread over five floors occupying nearly 47,000 square feet and is fully “one acre under one roof”. It’s unique furnishings include rare French 18th century furniture and there is a stunning, individual collection of great art.

The lushly landscaped grounds and woodlands encompass 222 acres with wildlife that includes red fox, white tail deer, blue heron, red tail and red shoulder hawks, orioles, merganser ducks and native yellow-eared sliders. This landscaped jewel in the Brandywine Valley is a fitting crown for the legacy of Alfred I. duPont.

The Region’s Finest Naturalistic Gardens, **Mt. Cuba Center** is recognized as having the region’s finest woodland wildflower gardens. Learn about the history, design, and plant diversity that make Mt. Cuba Center a unique regional treasure. Stroll through formal gardens, woodland areas and meadow.
